Albinia (Scherf) Costello, age 93 of Conshohocken, died on Thursday, January 5, 2017. She was born in the Roxborough section of Philadelphia on March 19, 1923 daughter of the late Francis and Clara (McElhaney) Scherf. She was the beloved wife of the late Leo J. Costello for 47 years.
