April 15, 1928 - January 11, 2018

Anna Regina (Nolan) Zisk born in Conshohocken on April 15, 1928 to Ida Elizabeth (Clapham) Nolan and Dudley Aloysius Nolan died in her home on January 11, 2018 of natural causes. She was the last of seven girls born to the Nolan family. Her sisters, all deceased, were Elizabeth Bowe, Edna Stemple, Margaret Healy, Helen DelBuono, Agnes Scharff, and Anna Rose, (who died at age 2). The sisters lived on Spring Mill Avenue and took care of their mother and each other after their father died. Anna graduated from St. Matthew High School and after graduation was employed by the Bell Telephone Company as a telephone operator. She married George F. Zisk on November 20, 1955. (George recently died on May 11, 2017 of natural causes.) Anna and George eventually moved to her family homestead in Conshohocken. Anna was the last surviving Nolan daughter. She loved children and enjoyed helping her sisters with their young children. She became a full time mother and homemaker and was active in the church volunteering to raise money for the school fund and helping her sister, Helen, with the church Bingo. All of the sisters, except Margaret, lived nearby and all remained close throughout their entire lives. She enjoyed the family Christmas Party's at the DelBuono home and later the family reunion party's at the Scharff's. Anna was always available to babysit and was instrumental in raising her own grandchildren. She was a mother to three children: Sheila Marie (deceased), George Jr. and Pattie Ann. George Jr. and wife Donna Jean (Rippert) reside in Hatfield, PA and have three children: George III,

Brendan and Jeanine. Pattie and husband Brian Adamson live in Voorhees, NJ and have three children: Bryce, Brooke and Brandon. She is blessed with ten great grandchildren. She will be remembered for her kindness and generosity. She was an avid "Wheel of Fortune and Jeopardy" fan and mostly enjoyed a quiet life with her family and friends.
