



Anthony Mancuso Jr.

July 20, 1923 - May 25, 2018

Anthony Mancuso, Jr., “Tony/Gubby,” age 94 of Conshohocken, died on Friday, May 25th, 2018 at home surrounded by family. He was born in Philadelphia on July 20, 1923, son of the late Anthony Sr. and Rose (Cossetti) Mancuso. He was the beloved husband of Connie (Lassen) Mancuso for 35 years.

Tony grew up in the Mount Airy section of Philadelphia. He was a decorated United States World War II Army Combat veteran. Tony served as a member of the 101st Airborne “Screaming Eagles”, 907 HQ Battery, fighting courageously in some of the most intense and pivotal battles of the European Theater which include Normandy Invasion, Battle of the Bulge, and the Liberation of Holland. After the war, he worked as a foreman for Dan Lepore & Sons before venturing off and establishing his own company, Tony Mancuso Masonry. He enjoyed boating, fishing, watching the Phillies, breakfast with the boys, and helping others. Above all, Tony was proud of his honorable service in World War II and had the utmost love for his family.

In addition to his wife Connie, he is survived by Connie’s children Linda C. Eisenhart (Ross) of Plymouth Meeting, Anthony R. Viola (Linda) of Texas and formerly New Jersey, Connie A. Loomis (Jay) of Oaks, George W. Viola (Denise) of Jeffersonville, ten grandchildren, Ashley, Corrie, Justin, Anthony, Kristen, Jaycie, Stefan, Eric, Sarah, Rachel, great-grandson Michael, sister-in-

law Carol Strauser (Harry), and many nieces and nephews, all of whom he loved dearly. He is also survived by a daughter, Diane DiPrinzio, two grandchildren, Tara and Jason, and two great-grandchildren. He was predeceased by four brothers, Vincent, Sam, John, and Joe, and three sisters, Jane Moore, Rose Marra, and Fran Werden.
