Anthony Michael Nasielski Jr., age 61 of West Norriton and formerly Conshohocken, died on Wednesday, November 14, 2018. He was born in Conshohocken on October 6, 1957 son of the late Anthony Michael Sr. and Joan (Rowe) Nasielski.

Mike was raised on West 4th Ave in Conshohocken, where he was a lifelong parishioner of St. Matthew RC Church. He attended St. Matthew grade school and graduated from Plymouth Whitemarsh High School Class of 1975. He also studied music at Temple University. Mike was active in a variety of St. Matthew Parish activities serving as a lector, a cantor and a member of the choir. Mike also frequented services at Paoli Presbyterian Church. He was employed as a restaurant manager for several local venues throughout his life.
