Anthony R. Todd, Sr., age 68, of Philadelphia, PA, formally of Conshohocken, passed away on April 28, 2020.

Born and raised in Conshohocken, Anthony played the drums in the Conshy High School band until its closing and graduated from PW. Known as “Tony” in the music business, he continued his musical career playing drums and singing vocals for bands such as Down To Earth, Harold Reynolds Band, Donnie (Mathis) and Tony Duo, Wildflower and others. He was most noted as a member of the band Love Train. He was also the pianist /vocalist for many churches and offered his services at many home going services for family and friends.

Anthony was also an artist and historian.

Anthony worked as a trucker deliveryman for Stroehmann Bread for 10 years and retired from Loews in 2018.

Anthony is survived by his sisters: Sandra Harris (Raymond) of Wildwood, NJ and Reida Todd of Norristown, PA; partner, Tanya Willis of Philadelphia, PA; daughter Erica Colón, of Little Ferry, NJ and son, Anthony “Tony” R. Todd, Jr. (Yolonda) of Coatesville, PA. He was a grandfather to grandsons: Isaiah, Elijah and Avery; and granddaughter Ava. He also leaves behind nieces and

nephews: Andre, Torey, Deidria, Justin and Rayna; a host of grand and great nieces and nephews, a goddaughter, cousins and friends. He was preceded in death by his parents Emily (Dozier) and Reid K. Todd of Conshohocken, PA.
