Bernard Patrick McKenna, age 79 of North Wales and formerly Lower Gwynedd, died on Sunday, December 24, 2017 after a brief illness. He was born in Conshohocken on August 18, 1938 son of the late Barney and Sarah (McPeak) McKenna. He was the beloved husband of Jeanette (Jemionek) McKenna for 55 years.

Born and raised in Conshohocken, Bernard graduated from Conshohocken High School Class of 1956. He earned his MBA from Baldwin Wallace College in Berea, Ohio. Bernard served his country honorably in the United States Army National Guard. He was employed by BP Oil and affiliates as an executive salesman for 35 years stationed around the Midwest and east coast.
