Bernardine Victoria (Narwicz) Frangiosa, age 78 of Plymouth Meeting, PA and formerly Conshohocken passed away on Sunday, December 26, 2021. She was the daughter of the late Alfonse and Leokadja “Maryann Loretta” (Stuczynski) Narwicz.

Bernardine grew up on West 3rd Ave. in Conshohocken. She attended St. Mary’s grade school and graduated from St. Matthew High School, Class of 1960. She worked with TV Guide immediately after high school and then helped her husband run the family deli, “Master Deli” in Plymouth Meeting, for many years. She appeared as an extra in several movies in the 1970s and early 1980s, including “Atlantic City” (1980), “Dressed to Kill” (1979), “Rocky II” (1978), and “Manhattan” (1978), and enjoyed modeling and appearing in television commercials and industrial films. She was a member of SAG and AFTRA. More recently, she worked with several financial investment companies, including PNC Global Investing, PFPC, and Bank New York Mellon, from which she retired as a Senior Specialist in Investor Services in 2013.

After she retired, she loved traveling, visiting her daughter in southern California, spending time with her grandchildren and socializing with her family and friends. She was a member of the board of the Our Lady of Mount Carmel Sodality, volunteered with the Leukemia & Lymphoma Society and with the Woodmere Museum in Chestnut Hill, and was a member of the Sons and

Daughters of Italy, LAM Valley Forge Lodge #1776.

She is survived by her loving husband of 56 years, Vincent James, her children Vincent (Christina) Frangiosa and Victoria (Ford) Kaufholz, and grandchildren Jessica and Alexander.
