Chester Bielawski Jr., "Butch", age 81 of West Conshohocken, died peacefully at home in his sleep on Sunday, July 7th, 2024. He was born on April 10, 1943 son of the late Chester and Helen M. (Kunaszuk) Bielawski. He was the beloved husband of the late Joyce (Licwinko) Bielawski.

Chester was a proud descendant of Polish immigrants. A true Conshohocken classic, he was a Conaughtown kid born out of the steel mills, where many of his family and friends worked. Growing up in true "Conshy" style, he competed in the Soap Box Derby and played football for St. Matthew's and Plymouth Whitemarsh high schools.

Chester started his working career and industrious work ethic very young, cutting lawns as a teenager. He later gave many years to F.J. Woolworth Company, where he managed several Woolco stores across Pennsylvania. He later worked for the Columbia Boiler Company out of King of Prussia and Pottstown, where he eventually retired. Over the years, he had many small side businesses, where he would employ friends and family.

Growing up and playing football in the steel town of Conshohocken, and then later living in Pittsburgh during the 70s, Chester had a great fondness for football, but most of all for the Pittsburgh Steelers. He enjoyed watching movies, Polka music, Polish food, and playing the accordion.

He is survived by son Robert Bielawski, and grandchildren Timothy Bielawski, Kyle Rymarowicz, Brittany Rymarowicz, Amber Davis, Ronald Davis Jr., Leah Davis, Justin Bielawski, 10 great-grandchildren, brother Jan Bielawski, and sisters Gerry Drozd, Diane Bianco, and Helen Fox.

He was preceded in death by his wife, Joyce Bielawski (Licwinko), son Gerald Bielawski, daughter JoyAnne Rymarowicz, and daughter Michele Davis.

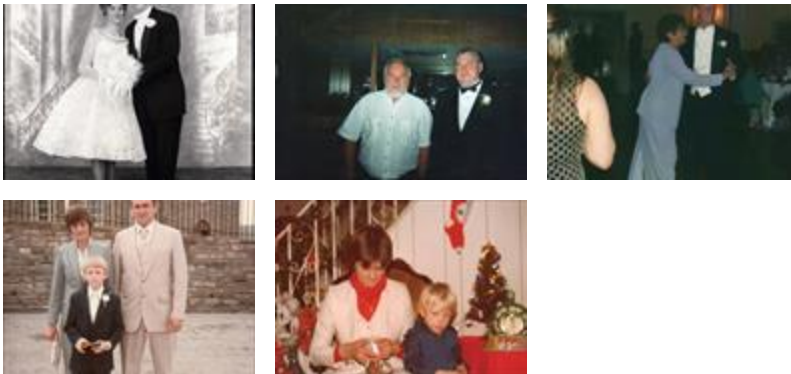
