Dennis Keith Cramer, age 72 of King of Prussia, died on Friday, March 15. He was born in Burlington, New Jersey on November 21, 1946, son of Clarence and Eleanor.

Dennis was a proud veteran of the United States Armed Forces, having served in the Army for nearly four years with an honorable discharge. He was stationed at Ft.
