



## Elizabeth "Beth" Moulton

December 30, 1958 - January 26, 2022

Elizabeth "Beth" Moulton, 63, of Audubon, passed away suddenly on January 26, 2022. A Conshohocken native and award-winning author, she was born on December 30, 1958, and is survived by her father, Richard H. Moulton, of Conshohocken, brothers Rick (Diane) Moulton of Plymouth Township, and Mike (Shelly Sabo) Moulton of Bowling Green, Ohio, sister Sandy (Bob) Miller, of North Wales, many beloved nieces and nephews, and her adoring cats, Lucy and Ethel. She was predeceased by her mother, Helen (Nyce) Moulton, twin sister Bonnie Moulton, and sister Kathleen van Beekom.

Beth's career included over 30 years in the pharmaceutical and healthcare industries, serving in various roles for Upjohn and GSK, and most recently as a software tester for Quest Diagnostics. She retired from the corporate arena a few years ago to concentrate on her true passion – creative writing. Beth's forte were short stories and poetry, with inspiration frequently drawn from regional historic and geographic features as well as familiar personalities and acquaintances. Her work garnered several awards and appeared in a variety of literary publications.

Beth was the first to become a member of the Creative Light Factory community of creatives in Spring City, and served on their Board of Directors for the past year. She was also a member of the organization's Just Write writers group. Her love of, and talent for writing inspired so many on the

creative path. Beth earned her undergraduate degree from Cabrini University and a Master of Fine Arts in Creative Writing from Rosemont College. She was also a member of Mensa International, and virtually unbeatable at Scrabble and other word games. She enjoyed trivia competitions, genealogy research, traveling, and history – including volunteering as a Revolutionary War reenactor at Washington’s Headquarters at Valley Forge National Historical Park.
