Janet “Jan” A. (Lokitis) Duda, age 85 of Conshohocken, died on Monday, February 1, 2021. She was born in Shamokin, PA on October 18, 1935 daughter of the late Nicholas and Estelle Irene (Kerstetter) Lokitis. She was the beloved wife of John “Jack” L. Duda for over 63 years.
