Joseph Alexander Duda, age 80 of Conshohocken, died on Tuesday, October 2, 2018. He was born in Norristown on February 12, 1938 son of the late Joseph and Jean (Mrozek) Duda. He was the beloved husband of Eileen (Smith) Duda for over 48 years.

Joe was raised in Conshohocken where he attended St. Matthew grade school and graduated from Conshohocken High School Class of 1955.
