Joseph J. Heleniak, age 93 of Conshohocken, died on Sunday, November 6th, 2016. He was born in Swedesburg, PA on January 27, 1923 son of the late Jacob and Amelia (Geslak) Heleniak. He was the beloved husband of the late Isabella (Giera) Heleniak.

Joe was raised in the Swedesburg section of Upper Merion Township graduating from Upper Merion High School. He was a United States Army WWII Veteran serving in the European Theatre of the War. He served as a medic with a hospital ship platoon, which carried wounded soldiers from battlefields in Europe to Brooklyn, NY. He was employed as a machinist for Walker Brothers in Conshohocken and later Hale Pump in Conshohocken. He was a member of the VFW Post 1074 in Conshohocken. He was a simple, salt of the earth man, who loved woodworking, gardening and working with his hands. Joe and his wife Isabella raised their family in Conshohocken, where they were parishioners of St. Matthew RC Church.
