Joseph Tropiano Sr., 84 of Wayne, PA, died on Wednesday, July 12th, 2017. He was the beloved husband of Norma (Pelosi) Tropiano married 58 years and the father of Paula Tropiano of Exton, PA and Joseph Tropiano, Jr. (Suzi), and grandfather of Cecelia and Nicholas of Maple Glen, PA. He was born in South Philadelphia on August 12, 1932 to the late Salvatore and Carmella (Galvani) Tropiano. He was predeceased by three brothers, Francis, Dominic and Rocco; and five sisters Catherine, Madeline, Anna, Rita and Antoinette and survived by sister Delores and younger brother Anthony and many nieces and nephews.

Joseph Tropiano was a proud patriot serving in the United States Army, Korean War combat Veteran.
