

Margaret Regina Lacey

November 30, 1947 - August 20, 2022

Margaret Regina Lacey was born on November 30, 1947 at Sacred Heart Hospital in Norristown. Her parents were Daniel and Mary (Tiernan) McGee. She was raised in Conshohocken and graduated from St. Matthew High School in 1965. She worked for a variety of companies in the capacity of secretary, the last being with RSVP (Retired Senior Volunteer Program).

Margaret, known widely and intimately as "Peggy", raised three daughters on her own, lived in Clayton, New Jersey from 1983-1992, and resettled in Conshohocken, where she found her way to First Baptist Church and met Pastor Brad Lacey. They shared friendship and partnership in ministry together, and were married on September 28, 1996.

Peggy quickly became one of the "pillars" of the church. She was affectionately known by many as the "First Lady" of First Baptist and lent herself in service to Christ and God's people in every conceivable way; from menial duties to leading worship and teaching children and women's classes, to sharing the Word. She was deeply devoted to Jesus Christ, His Gospel and His people. She was a devoted wife, mother, grandmother and friend who loved to sew and to serve, with hospitality being her specialty.

Peggy traveled with Pastor Lacey to Russia and India in missionary service. She was a bonafide "Conshy Girl," who never lost her sense of origin, but who

had also become a citizen of the broader and deeper Kingdom of God. She loved Jesus deeply, and her love for Him spread into all aspects of her life, as into the way she received and valued everyone. She was always ready to give her time and offer counsel, and many were the beneficiaries of her counsel and her hospitality.

She was the glue that held her family together. And she was a woman of conviction, maintaining her values without compromise, and was willing to pay the price for it, as she did innumerable times on behalf of unborn babies.

Peggy was diagnosed with pancreatic cancer in March of this year; suffered terrible, but has now ascended into God's Presence, where she is rid of her pain, having completed her God-given work, and finds rest, peace and joy in the presence of the Lord, to whom she gave her life in devotion.

Beside her husband, Brad, Peggy is survived by: 3 daughters, Bridgid McGee, Cindy Pessoa and Shannon McGee; 2 brothers, Larry and Dennis; a sister, Mary Kendus; 5 grandchildren, Sierra, Christian, Joshua, Justin, and Amber; a great-granddaughter, Lylah; many nieces, nephews, cousins and friends. She was predeceased by: 2 brothers, Daniel and John; and her sister, Patty Rodenbaugh.
