Marianne Wilson, 82, of King of Prussia, PA passed away peacefully on Sunday, March 8, 2020, surrounded by her loving family. She was the beloved wife of Robert J. Wilson for 58 beautiful years. She settled in King of Prussia and raised her four children in the home where she lived out her final days. She held the title of bookkeeper for her husband's business of 44 years. She was a lifelong parishioner of Mother of Divine Providence Church, where she served as a volunteer for countless school and parish fundraising events. Perhaps her greatest achievement was as a devoted daughter, wife, mother, grandmother,

and loyal friend. Her deep faith carried her through the loss of her two children and helped her appreciate her many blessings. She enjoyed daily five-mile walks in Valley Forge Park, her competitive matches on the tennis court, reading books, and spending summers with her family in Sea Isle City, NJ, walking the beaches and collecting sea glass with her grandchildren. All who knew her will miss her excellent cooking, baking, and thoughtful care packages. She was a selfless and strong woman that graced this world with love, positivity, and an indomitable spirit.
