Michael Joseph Kearney Jr., "MJ", age 73 of Conshohocken and formerly Scranton, died suddenly on Friday, July 19, 2019. He was born in Scranton, PA on March 26, 1946 son of the late Michael Joseph Sr. and Mary Colette (Lavin) Kearney. He was the beloved husband of Mary Louise (McGlone) Kearney "Meezy" for over 51 years.

Michael was born and raised in Scranton, PA graduating from Scranton Prep in 1964. He then attended Georgetown University graduating in 1968. Also in 1968; he married the love of his life, Mary Louise McGlone "Meezy". They set up their family homestead in Conshohocken and raised their daughter Melissa.
