Muriel Clark Corrigan, aged 75, died peacefully on March 20 from cancer. She was at home with her husband Gerald (Gerry) and children by her side, in her Traditions at Skippack (TAS) residence. Muriel was born November 3, 1941 in Conshohocken, PA, the daughter of the late J. Donald and Muriel (Harper) Clark.

In 1963, Muriel married the love of her life Gerald Corrigan Jr., and embarked on a life as a proud Marine Corps wife.
