Nicola Peter DePallo, "Big Nick", age 73 of Norristown, passed away on Sunday, January 16, 2022. Nick was born on Tuesday, January 27, 1948 son of the late Victor and Pauline (Cognato) DePallo. He was the beloved husband of Marie (Amato) DePallo for 50 years.

Nick was born and raised on W. 6th Ave. in Conshohocken, where he attended Ss. Cosmas & Damian RC Church. He graduated from the Pennsylvania School for the Deaf, where he was captain of the football team and later inducted into the Hall of Fame for football, baseball and basketball. He was employed as a print press operator by Bell Atlantic for over 35 years. He enjoyed, walking, grocery shopping, cooking, and being a Philadelphia sports fan. Above all, he loved being a father and grandfather.

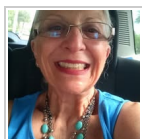
