Niko Giovanni Barattucci, age 25 of Conshohocken, passed away on Friday, August 19th, 2022. He was born on February 18, 1997 son of David and Jill (Santino) Barattucci.

Niko was raised on Sutcliffe Lane. He was the epitome of a “Conshy Boy”. He attended Conshohocken Catholic grade school, Colonial Middle School and graduated from Plymouth Whitemarsh High School, Class of 2015. Some of Niko’s proudest moments were playing for the Conshohocken Bears, Conshohocken Little League and the Conshohocken Bulldogs. He adored and admired all his coaches, teammates and the memories they created. He was also a member of the PW Swim Team.

After high school; he trained with Smith & Solomon earning his CDL-A. He was employed by the Conshohocken Borough and later Infrasource. He was a proud member of Local 57 Laborer’s Union. Niko enjoyed: trucks, motorcycles, trips, the Jersey Shore and especially bike week.

Niko combined his love for people and motorcycles by participating in many memorial rides in honor of others. Those are the kind of things he did for strangers and friends alike.

It has been said by many that Niko's smile lit up a room. You always knew the moment you saw him how much he cared about you. That smile was followed by the infamous hug that only Niko could give. His hugs would make you feel warm and special and everything felt okay when you got one.

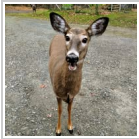
