



## Patricia Ann Montemayor

December 7, 1946 - November 2, 2017

Patricia Ann (Burton) Montemayor, age 70 of King of Prussia, died on Thursday, November 2, 2017. She was born in Philadelphia on December 7, 1946 daughter of the late William C. and Tina C. (Pellegrino) Burton. She was the beloved wife of Robert J. Montemayor for over 51 years.

Loving her family first and foremost, Pat also became actively involved in community activities. She supported her daughters' activities in scouting and sports. She served as chaperone for the Liberty Belle Strutters' trip to the World's Fair in Tennessee; manager for her daughter's UMBA championship softball team; a member of MDP's Parish Council; and a Caley Rd. PTC Officer. She was instrumental in reviving the Sweetbriar-Hidden Valley Civic Assn. and successfully opposed attempts to build multifamily units in single family home neighborhoods. Patricia participated in fund raising for several charities including Easter Seals, Cancer Society and countless local causes.

She also donated her time and talents to political and governmental activities serving as judge of elections at her local polls; member of National Federation of Republican Women; served as Montco GOP Committee Person for Belmont II District for over 20 years; appointed to first UM Twp. Study Group on bankrupt Lafayette Swim Club, which is now the beautiful Upper Merion Swim and Tennis Club; was only the second woman to serve on UM Twp. Zoning Hearing Board and the first to serve as chairperson.

Pat's final act of selfless generosity was in providing much needed tissue and bone donations through The Gift of Life organization, helping to save and improve the lives of others.

Pat was best known as a loving wife, mother, grandmother and great-grandmother, who was always willing to roll up her sleeves to help friends and community alike. A woman of great humility; she would never have wanted any of this written, but we could also never let her good work go unrecognized.

She is survived by her husband, Robert, 2 daughters, Roberta M. Montemayor (Scott Bolger) of Philadelphia and Jennifer D. Mace (Tom) of Langhorne; 5 grandchildren, (Kayleigh, Jacob, Ryan, Lindsay, and Owen) and great granddaughter, Elizabeth.
