Philip A. Taddeo, age 91 of Wayne and also Naples, FL, passed away on Thursday, June 5th 2025. He was born on April 28th, 1934 son of the late Frank and Concetta (Covelli) Taddeo. He was the beloved husband of the late Jane Rose (Bozewicz) Taddeo for over 60 years.

Philip was born at home in Strafford PA and grew up in St. David's PA. Growing up, Phil was baptized at Our Lady of Assumption Church and attended St. Katherine's parish in Wayne, PA. As a teenager, Phil worked doing maintenance at the Mainline Golf Club in Radnor where he developed a passion for golf. Phil attended Radnor High School where he played football and volunteered at the Radnor Fire Company. Upon graduating high school, he received a scholarship to attend Villanova University graduating in 1956 with a Bachelor of Arts Degree in History. Following Villanova, he enlisted in the US Army and was commissioned as an officer and assigned to the 2nd Armor Division at Ft. Hood TX. After his active duty service, he served in the US Army Reserve retiring after 23+ years as a Lt. Colonel. After his active duty service, Phil was also employed by Scott Paper Company in Chester, PA where he worked 30+ years eventually retiring there as the executive vice-president running their procurement and logistics operations. While at Scott Paper Phil also attended executive education programs at Harvard University. Phil resided in Wayne, PA with his family while working and was an active member and leader at St Mary Parish in Conshohocken, PA. Upon retirement

he moved to Naples, Fl where he was actively involved in the community, enjoyed playing golf, and spending time with his wife, children, grandchildren and extended family.

Philip is survived by: a son, Philip M. (Jean Marie); a brother, Americo; a sister, Carol Taddeo; 2 grandchildren, Gillian Alyssa and Giavanna Clare Taddeo; many nieces, nephews, cousins and dear friends. Beside his wife, Jane, Phil was predeceased by his daughter, Jennifer Taddeo; his brother, Frank and his sister, Mary Clemens.
