



## Richard H. Moulton

August 15, 1932 - August 8, 2024

Richard H. Moulton, age 91 of Conshohocken, passed away peacefully on Thursday, August 8, 2024. He was the beloved husband of the late Helen C. (Nyce) Moulton.

Richard was born on the family farm in Elkton, South Dakota, to Benjamin F. and Ella Mae (Cushie) Moulton on August 15, 1932. He graduated Elkton High School in 1950 and enlisted in the U.S. Air Force, honorably serving as an F-86 Sabre mechanic and crew chief during the Korean War, stationed at bases in Korea, Japan and stateside. After the war, he frequently traveled to Conshohocken while assigned in Langley, Virginia, with his friend and then future brother-in-law, George Weidamoyer. It was during these trips that he met and fell in love with Helen. At the end of his enlistment, he subsequently settled in Conshohocken, and married her on September 15, 1956. Richard was employed by Alan Wood Steel and Hamilton Paper, and retired after working the final 24 years of his career with Trane Thermal. He was a member of St. Matthew Parish and enjoyed gardening and tending to his yard, visiting with family and friends, and rooting for the Phillies and Eagles.

He is survived by sons Richard (Diane) of Conshohocken and Michael (Shelly) of Bowling Green, Ohio; daughter Sandra Moulton of Conshohocken; brother Vern of Sioux Falls, South Dakota; half-brother Arnold Moulton of Lakeside, Arizona; eight grandsons, a granddaughter, ten great-grandchildren;

and many nieces, nephews, cousins and friends.

In addition to his loving wife and parents, Richard was predeceased by daughters Beth Moulton, Bonnie Moulton and Kathleen vanBeekom; grandson Jayson vanBeekom, sister Edith Lamp, brothers Donald Moulton and Darrell Moulton, and half-sister Gladys Moulton Graham.

Relatives and friends are invited to pay respects on Tuesday, August 13, from 9 – 10:20 AM at St. Matthew RC Church, 219 Fayette St., Conshohocken. Mass will immediately follow at 10:30 AM, and Richard will be laid to rest at St. Matthew Cemetery in Conshohocken.
