August 10, 1968 - January 11, 2017

Robin L. (Reynolds) Stutzman, age 48 of King of Prussia, died suddenly on Wednesday, January 11, 2017. She was born in Bethel, CT on August 10, 1968 daughter of Barbara (Newton) Reynolds and the late Robert Reynolds. Robin was the beloved wife of Brian D. Stutzman for 25 years.

Robin's family moved to King of Prussia while she was in grade school, where she attended Candlebrook Elementary. Robin graduated from Upper Merion High School Class of 1986, where she was an accomplished soccer player. She was employed as a bookkeeper for Kravco Corp., O'Neill Properties and most recently Morgan Properties. Robin was an advocate of youth athletics within the Upper Merion Community, where she served on the Athletic Board as treasurer for the lacrosse team and was active in both the football and lacrosse boosters. She was simply the quintessential definition of a wife and mother always putting her family first and loving them with all her heart.

She is survived by: 5 children, Casey, Brian Jr., Liam, Connor and Ian, all of King of Prussia; a brother, Rande Reynolds of Marlton, NJ; 8 nieces and nephews and 4 great-nephews. Predeceased by a brother, Ryan Reynolds.

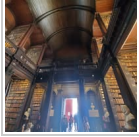
