As a young man; Ron knew the value of hard work, where he worked at the family grocery store on Maple Street in Conshohocken, Greco Super Grocery Market, stocking canned goods and delivering groceries to neighbors, priests

and sisters. Before school he would go to the local dairy and milk cows. On weekends, he would work at Alan Wood Steel Mill. Somehow he always managed time for his three horses: Springtime, Thunder and Reds. He had his own landscaping business, where he employed many of his high school football team.

Ron attended Conshohocken High School, and later, transferred to Saint Matthew's High School, Class of 1953; where he quickly emerged as star quarterback and excelled on the gridiron. His talent on the field was undeniable; lettering, and being named All State as starting quarterback. Upon graduation, he went on to serve his country honorably by enlisting in the United States Army amid the Korean War conflict. He was stationed overseas in the Office of Strategic Service (MI). After his military service, he furthered his studies at Villanova University Class of 1960 receiving his Bachelor of Science Degree. Ron also was a realtor; Muntz TV franchise owner in Newark, NJ; used car salesman; commercial roofing contractor; most recently proprietor of Best Construction Services. He was still climbing roofs at the age of 85, but anyone who knew him, that was no surprise.

Besides, his wife, Beverly, he is survived by a son, Ronald R. Greco, Jr., two daughters, Dr. Valerie Hunt and Angela Greco, several grandchildren and great grandchildren, nieces and nephews and friends. He was pre-deceased by his brother Anthony.
