Rosemary Elizabeth Massimini, 73, of Conshohocken Pa passed away on January 17, 2025.

Rosemary was born on May 22, 1951 to John “Jack” Dempsey and Louise “Gigi” (Bruni) Dempsey. Rosemary was born and lived her whole life in Conshohocken. She went to St. Matthew’s Elementary School and graduated from Kennedy High School in 1969. Rosemary married Paul Massimini in 1973 and they enjoyed 51 years of marriage. Rosemary worked for Bell Telephone and James G Biddle after high school and then paused working to raise her two boys Paul and Michael. When she returned to work, she found a passion working with children, working in several area daycare centers and then the Colonial School District as an Instructional Aide until she retired around 2013. Rosemary was a most devoted and loving wife, mother, grandmother, sister and friend. She loved her family and friends, her trips to Jamaica, being a child advocate and caring for pets (many dogs, cats, rabbits, birds, and more over the years). Her hobbies included water color painting, taking walks and gardening with roses being her favorite flower. Rosemary was driven by her faith in Jesus and was the first female Eucharistic minister at St. Mary’s Church in the 1980’s and later an active member of St. Matthew’s Parish.

Rosemary was preceded in life by her mother and father and her son Paul

who passed away in 2014. In addition to her husband Paul, Rosemary is survived by her son Michael Massimini, daughter-in-law Salve (Batu) Massimini; three grandchildren: Giuliana "Gigi" Massimini, Sofia Massimini and Leo Massimini; sister Jacqueline Stewart; niece Jennifer DeFelice, nephew John Stewart and their respective children.
