



Theodore G. Cavan

March 1, 1946 - January 22, 2024

Theodore G. (Todd) Cavan, 77, of North Wales PA, passed away at home on Monday, January 22, 2024.

Todd was born in Wilkes Barre, PA on March 1, 1946, the son of the late Gerard and Rita (Shearba) Cavan. He was preceded in death by his wife of 42 years, Nancy (Brady) Cavan. He has been living in North Wales, formerly of Blue Bell, PA

After graduating from Kendrick High School, Todd served in the US Air Force, stationed in Thailand, during the Vietnam War, and honorably discharged November 4, 1970. He then went on to graduate in 1971 from Quaker City School of Aeronautics. While serving in Thailand, he was responsible for maintaining the engines of fighter jets. He often stated one of his biggest regrets: sometimes the planes he worked on never came back to base. It was that dedication to his military service that followed him throughout life, especially as a member of Vietnam Veterans of America Chapter 590, where he actively participated for many years. He enjoyed marching in holiday parades with the 590 Chapter, attending air shows, building & creating model train platforms, and taking his boat on the lake for an afternoon of fishing.

Todd was employed by various pharmaceuticals companies throughout his career as a machinist/mechanic. He retired in 2011 from Teva Pharmaceutical, North Wales, PA

Todd is survived by his sister Claudette Quimby (Mark), his brother Joel Cavan (Darlene), his sister in-law & brother in-law Carol (Brady) & Leo Lorenz, along with many nieces and nephews.

Along with his wife and parents, he as preceded in death by his twin brother Gerard Cavan.
