Thomas J. Hurley Sr., “Bud”, age 93 of E. Greenville and formerly of Bridgeport, died at home with family at his side on Thursday, May 3, 2018. He was born in Norristown on April 28, 1925 son of the late Thomas G. and Mary (Kriebel) Hurley. He was the beloved husband of Dorothy (Snow) Hurley for 72 years.

Bud graduated from Norristown High School Class of 1943. Then in 1943 as WWII was raging; he enlisted in the United States Navy. He was stationed in Iwo Jima where he was involved in intense combat for 3 1/2 years and was there when the famous image of the American flag was raised. For his honorable service as a combat veteran, he was awarded the Pacific Theater Ribbon w/ 1 star, Good Conduct Medal, American Theater Ribbon, WWII Victory Medal and a Bronze Star. He was employed as a pipe fitter and plumber by Phillip Carey in Plymouth Meeting and later Penwalt in King of Prussia. He loved all things to do with sports and was a highly regarded baseball coach for the Bridgeport Little League. In summary, he saw his life’s work come full circle through his grandchildren, whom he loved dearly and was very much an active part of their lives.
