



## Thomas "Tommy" Maloney

July 5, 1934 - November 3, 2025

Thomas Maloney "Tommy", age 91 of Conshohocken; passed away peacefully at home accompanied by family on Monday, November 3, 2025. He was born on July 5, 1934 son of the late Thomas F. and Mary Catherine (Ruser) Maloney. He was the beloved husband of Margaret (Beswick) Maloney for over 63 years.

Tommy was a lifelong resident of Conshohocken attending St. Matthew Church & grade school. He was a 1952 graduate of St. Matthew High School; where he was an integral member of the football team. He was drafted into the United States Army serving honorably in the 588th Engineer Battalion out of Fort Dix and was stationed in Greenland. He was called back to service in 1961 during the Cuban Missile Crisis serving with the 333rd Engineer Special Service Regiment. Tommy served a total of 6 years. Tommy was a 65 year member of the Local 420 Steam Fitters Union (Philadelphia). He was a multi-talented and hands on guy who loved to help and teach others; especially his grandchildren. He enjoyed gardening, tinkering, building, and hunting among many other interests. Tommy also volunteered and contributed to numerous Church activities and local charities; such as St. Matthew St. Vincent DePaul Society and food bank. Above all; he was the proud patriarch of his family and once in a lifetime friend to many.

Beside his wife Margaret; he is survived by: 2 sons, Thomas J. (Patricia) and

Robert (Tracy); a daughter, Susan Maloney; 2 sisters, Mary Catherine Hurst and Ellen D. Maloney; 9 grandchildren (Brittany, Leila) (Alexa, Robert) (Brooke, Sarah, Catherine, Phoebe) (William); 3 great-grandchildren Owen, Luna and Westley; many nieces, nephews and dear friends.
