William A. "Bill" Stitt of West Conshohocken, PA, passed away peacefully, surrounded by family, on May 22, 2019. He was 89. Bill was the beloved husband of Priscilla A. (nee Pancereve), for 64 years. He was the loving father of William E. of Wellington, FL and David A. (Bernadette) of Villanova, PA. He was a devoted grandfather to 6 grandsons, 1 granddaughter - and 1 great-grandson. He will be also dearly missed by many cousins, nieces and nephews.

Bill was the son of the late William E. and Marie (nee Loeffler) Stitt, and brother of the late Gladys (Richard) Fuhrer, all of Oakmont, PA. He graduated from Shadyside Academy, where he played on the football and golf teams, and the University of Pittsburgh, where he met his lovely bride.

In his early years, Bill served in the U.S. Army Counterintelligence Corps during the Korean War. His long and rewarding career in the steel industry with Jones & Laughlin and LTV Corporation brought him and his family to Boston and York before settling in the Philadelphia area in the mid-1960's. While a member of Christ Church in Ithan, Bill served as an Episcopalian Deacon for many years. An avid golfer, he was a member of several courses, his home courses being Merion Golf Club and Pine Valley. One of the positions he enjoyed most was serving as Chairman of the Greens Committee for the 1981 U.S. Open at Merion.

Bill greatly enjoyed the boardwalk in Ocean City NJ, birding in Florida during winter, and listening to jazz and Vic Damone. He brought enormous joy to his family and many friends, especially on the golf course. We will miss him tremendously.
